_____ *Sign of Peace* - We offer one another Christ's peace.

_____ *Prayer Over the Offerings* - The priest prays that God will accept our sacrifice.

_____ *Gloria* - We praise God in song.

_____ *Prayer of the Faithful* - We pray for our needs and the needs of others.

_____ *Eucharist Prayer* - The center and high point of the entire celebration. It includes the Preface, Holy, Holy, Holy, Consecration, The mystery of Faith, & Amen

_____ *Gospel Acclamation* - We sing "Alleluia" to praise God for the Good News.

_____ *Lord's Prayer* - We pray the Our Father.

_____ *Greeting* - We pray the Sign of the Cross. The priest welcomes us.

_____ *Lamb of God* - We pray for forgiveness, mercy, and peace.

_____ *Penitential Rite* - We remember our sins and ask God for mercy.

_____ *First Reading* - We listen to God's word, usually from the Old Testament.

_____ *Entrance Chant* - We gather as a community and praise God in song.

_____ *Communion* - We receive the Body and Blood of Christ.

_____ *Collect* - We ask God to hear our prayers.

_____ *Second Reading* - We listen to God's word, from the New Testament.

_____ *Presentation & Preparation of the Gifts* - We bring gifts of bread and wine to the altar.

_____ *Final Blessing* - We receive God's blessing.

_____ *Profession of Faith* - We proclaim our faith through the Creed.

_____ *Homily* - The priest or deacon explains God's Word.

_____ *Gospel Reading* - We stand and listen to the Gospel of the Lord.

_____ *Dismissal* - We go in peace, glorifying the Lord by our lives.

_____ *Prayer after Communion* - We pray the Eucharist will strengthen us to live like Jesus.

_____ *Responsorial Psalm* - We respond to God's Word in song.
