The Seeing Leading the Blind

Focal Point

In this week's Gospel, Jesus asks: "Can a blind person guide a blind person? Won't both fall into the pit?" We simply cannot know God on our own, and we are blind without help. Christianity is a revelation of who he is and what he is doing.

As we work to see life more as God sees it, we'll keep these three principles in mind:

1. It makes sense that God does not make sense.
2. When God does not make sense, we can get to know him better.
3. Do not confuse life not making sense with God not making sense.

Discussion Questions
