



## Love + Glory

Readings: Acts 14:21-27 | Ps 145:8-9, 10-11, 12-13 | Rev 21:1-5a | Jn 13:31-33a, 34-35

### *focal point*

We want to be loved, and we want to share love freely, for that is the message of the Gospel. But do some of us want to be glorified? In order to manifest the kind of love that Jesus wants of us, we have to know the difference.

### *scripture*

Read aloud from the Gospel of John. Then read aloud two more times.  
Ask the group what words or phrases jump out at them and why.

### *discussion questions*

1. You have twenty-four hours left to spend with Jesus. What do you think He would do with you in this time period?
2. How do you define the difference between love & glory?
3. If love is the defining characteristic of a disciple, how would you assess where you are as a disciple today?
4. What lessons from this message do you feel the need to share with others in your life?

### *application*

A way that we can show we are not seeking our own glory is by glorifying the Lord and telling others about him. Be not afraid to love and be loved. To God be the Glory.
