



## You Are My Witnesses

Readings: Acts 1:1-11 | Ps 47:2-3, 6-7, 8-9 | Eph 1:17-23 | Lk 24:46-53

### *focal point*

Jesus called us to be his witness in the world. We are called to share our witness with our family, our friends, our co-workers... everybody! And guess what? You don't have to be a theologian or Bible scholar or a member of the clergy to share the experience and relationship that you have with God. You just have to be you. Our role is to share all that we have seen, heard, and experienced. God will do the changing of hearts.

### *scripture*

Read aloud from the Gospel of Luke. Then read aloud two more times.

Ask the group what words or phrases jump out to them and why.

### *discussion questions*

1. Think about your personal learning style. Do you learn best by seeing, hearing or doing?
2. What gets in the way or distracts us from sharing the gospel with everyone we encounter?
3. Has there been a time when you were afraid to share the Gospel? What did you do about it?
4. What actions can we take to become more equipped to be the witness God calls us to be?

### *application*

As you seek to share, to be his faithful witness, do so with a heart of prayer for those you are sharing; that your words be guided by the Holy Spirit. Pray diligently and depend fully on the work of the Spirit as you faithfully share.
