
Readings: Is 8:23–9:3 | Ps 27:1, 4, 13–14 | 1 Cor 1:10–13, 17 | Mt 4:12–23

Discussion Questions

1. Have you ever experienced a time where you thought God was calling you to something, but you wanted to discuss, have counsel, do research before responding to the call? What happened?
2. “They left their nets and followed.” Are there nets in your life that are distancing you or separating you from Jesus? How can we let go of those nets? (Note: the “nets” are not the responsibilities we have in our life because those can be ways of serving the Lord.)
3. Look at the invitation we gave you after Mass this Sunday. The Lord is inviting you to one of these actions listed inside the card based on the Gospel. Take a few moments to silently reflect with the Holy Spirit. Choose one that speaks to you, share why and how you will respond.
