INVITATION

Welcome to Saint Mary's Sacramental Preparation program! All baptized 2nd - 5th graders for this school year are invited to begin the process of preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Children who begin and satisfactorily complete preparation this year will receive:

First Reconciliation on Thursday, November 6, 2025 at 6:00pm

First Communion on April 25 & 26, 2026 at the weekend Masses

WHAT IS NEEDED BEFORE WE BEGIN?

***Registration opens in August and closes September 14, 2025**

ALL students, including Saint Mary Catholic School (SMCS), need to complete these four tasks before preparation can begin:

1 REGISTER YOU AND YOUR FAMILY AS PARISHIONERS AT SAINT MARY CATHOLIC CHURCH AT THE PARISH OFFICE.

*Is your child a student at SMCS, but you are registered at another parish? We need a letter from your pastor with permission for your child to receive sacraments here.

2 FILL OUT THE ONLINE REGISTRATION FORM FOR SACRAMENTAL PREP AT WWW.SAINTMARY.LIFE

3 PAY THE SACRAMENTAL PREP FEE.

4 BRING A COPY OF YOUR CHILD'S BAPTISM CERTIFICATE TO THE PARISH OFFICE IF THEY WERE NOT BAPTIZED AT SAINT MARY CATHOLIC CHURCH.

REQUIREMENTS

1. MASS & THE SACRAMENTS

Keep Holy the Lord's Day.

The Eucharistic Liturgy is the source and summit of our Catholic faith. Weekly Sunday Mass attendance is vital to the spiritual growth of every Catholic. **All students in Sacrament prep are required to sign in at whichever weekend Mass their family attends.** At weekly Mass, children experience the depths of God's love through the Word, the community, and the Eucharist. We also encourage parents to receive the sacrament of Reconciliation as frequently as you can. Making these two sacraments a priority will show your child that they are important for our daily lives. ***If the requirement of Sunday Mass is not met, First Holy Communion will be delayed.***

2. PARENT INVOLVEMENT

Building the Domestic Church.

We want to empower you to be the primary catechist in your home. **Monthly participation in Family Adventure Days are required.** Parents and children will pray, study and prepare together for the great Gift of forgiveness in confession and the Gift of Jesus in Holy Communion. The parish will provide guidance, materials, and support along the way through email, text, phone call and parent meetings. ***All in-person meetings are mandatory to meet sacrament preparation requirements.***

3. ONLINE CLASSES AND ASSIGNMENTS

An Engaging Way to Prepare Your Child.

We will utilize the Augustine Institute's First Reconciliation and First Communion preparation program called "Signs of Grace." This is a two part class--First Reconciliation has 7 sessions which will be completed in the fall, and First Communion has 8 sessions which will be completed in the spring. These classes are video-based with supplementary materials for parents and children to use together. It is our hope that this time will not only offer your child an increase in knowledge and understanding of the Catholic faith, but will also help them fall in love with Jesus.

SESSION DETAILS

Online class sessions should be done in order. **Do not do multiple sessions at once.** This is a process and should be done weekly. Dates for completing each session are listed on the back of this handout. PDF files are a part of the sessions, you may either print them out or read from the computer.

- 1 THE FIRST 4 SESSIONS BEGIN WITH A PARENT PREPARATION VIDEO. THIS VIDEO IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE BACKGROUND INFORMATION ABOUT THE UPCOMING SESSION. PLEASE WATCH THIS BEFORE SITTING DOWN WITH YOUR CHILD.**
- 2 PRAY WITH YOUR CHILD USING THE "LET'S PRAY AND INTRODUCTION" VIDEO. THEN GO THROUGH THE REST OF THE SESSION VIDEOS & READ ALONG.**
- 3 YOUR CHILD COMPLETES THE QUIZ ON THEIR OWN. THIS WILL HELP YOU TO SEE IF YOU NEED TO GO BACK AND REVIEW ANYTHING FROM THE SESSION WITH YOUR CHILD.**
- 4 CLOSE IN PRAYER.**
*Reading and answering the questions with the "Hope Springs Story" is optional.

PRO PARENT TIPS:

- Dedicate a specific day & time that you will do this weekly with your child. *Sundays right after Mass is the perfect time!*
- Parents have reported that sessions can take **30 - 60 minutes.** Do not wait until the last minute; we are able to track your progress and see if you binged the sessions!

CHECK OFF LIST

- Register your family as parishioners of Saint Mary Catholic Church.
- Register for classes and pay for Family Adventure Days and preparation for the sacraments.
- Bring a copy of baptismal certificate to the parish office (if not baptized at SMCC).
- Register for the online class portal on September 14 when it is emailed to you.
- Make sure you are receiving Flocknote emails/texts. Let us know if you are not receiving them!
